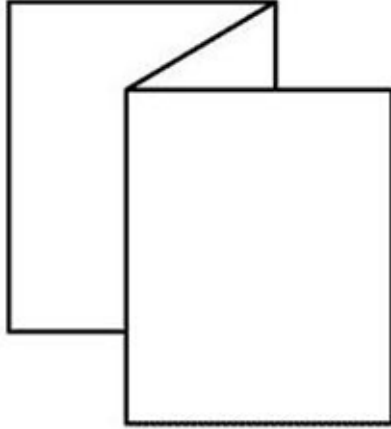


# Z-Fold Tri-Fold

Use for NBAS Nature Study Trails Brochure



A Z-fold is a document folding method that uses two parallel folds to create six panels of equal size – three panels on each side of the paper (3.66 inches per panel for letter sized paper).

The two folds are made in opposite directions, which forms a shape that resembles the letter Z.

The Z-fold method is commonly used for letters, flyers and brochures.

The Z-fold is sometimes referred to as an Accordion fold, a Fan fold or a Zig-Zag fold.
